

## **Bulgaria Will Not Seek IMF's Financial Support, Oresharski Says**

Oct. 28 (Bloomberg) -- Bulgarian Finance Minister Plamen Oresharski comments on government's plans to seek external financial help in case of liquidity crisis. He spoke at an economy conference in Sofia today.

``We are holding consultations with the IMF, the World Bank, the ECB and European Commission. We'll meet with IMF representatives at the end of this week. This doesn't mean we need any preliminary standby funding agreements.

``We have consultations with the IMF and the EC on general policies and coordination of projections. We'll continue doing this. At this stage, we have no intention of seeking preliminary standby funding agreements.

``We have ample fiscal reserves, which exceed government debt."
